## MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- x Bachelor's degree.
- x Experience as a player and/or coach in the sport.
- x Strong interpersonal and communication skills and the ability to establish and maintain effective relationships with students, faculty, staff, and the public.

## PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS

- x Five to seven years of experience directly related to the duties and responsibilities of the position.

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- x May provide general instruction and regular review to Assistant Coaches and/or student workers.
- x May require travel for sporting events and prolonged or irregular work hours, including evenings and/or weekends, during the competitive season.
- x Must maintain current CPR certification, AED and First Aid certification
- x Must participate in Southern Collegiate Athletic Conference groups for the sport.
